Transfer application No. 2461 in the name of Joseph Serres proposed a change in place of use of water from an unnamed stream, Pudding River and a reservoir under a certain water right with priority dates of June 23, 1949 and October 28, 1949, to irrigate a certain 4.6 acres in SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The order of the State Engineer, predecessor of the Water Resources

Director, entered on March 12, 1971 approving transfer application No. 2461,

provided "that no time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of
use is completed."

A survey by Water Resources Department staff revealed that the change in place of use under the order approving transfer No. 2461 was not completed; therefore, the subject water right is lost.
