ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND THE PARTIAL
DIMINUTION OF A WATER RIGHT

Pursuant to ORS 540.580, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8136, a petition submitted by

STANFIELD IRRIGATION DISTRICT

STANFIELD, OREGON 97875.

The rights to be modified are evidenced by portions of:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

Therefore, these changes to an existing district water right may be made subject to the following conditions:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.
2. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.
3. Proof, to the satisfaction of the Director, that the changes approved by this order have been completed must be submitted by STANFIELD IRRIGATION DISTRICT on or before October 1, 2000.

Furthermore,

4. Except as modified herein, all other conditions and restrictions of Certificate 54662 AND Permit 7400 remain in effect.
5. When the Director determines that it is necessary, or to facilitate records keeping, new certificates will be issued to confirm all completed changes for which satisfactory proof has been made and to confirm that portion of the right not modified by this or any other order.

In addition, on March 19, John Walchli submitted an affidavit stating that he is the owner of certain lands and the water right appurtenant. The affidavit further states he has obtained a better source of water for primary irrigation of these lands and requests the water right be diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation of that portion.

The water right, a portion of which is to be diminished, is described by Certificate 53263, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The water right allows the use of not to exceed 4.14 cubic feet per second of water from an Unnamed Stream, a tributary of the Columbia River, for the purpose of irrigation of

282.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 334.4 acres. The date of priority is January 21, 1965.

The portion of the right appurtenant to the property owned by John Walchli to be diminished is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of Certificate 53263 described above is diminished to supplemental use and a confirming certificate be issued to reflect the diminution.
