Findings of Fact

- 1. On April 26, 2019, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the temporary changes proposed in Application T-13127. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 112, Page 1064.
- 2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2023 irrigation season.
- 3. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer was during the 2020 irrigation season.
- 4. On January 5, 2021, Duane Eder of Eder Bros., Inc. submitted a written request that the temporary transfer be voluntarily terminated.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer T-13127 is terminated, and is no longer of any use or affect. The use shall revert to points of diversion and the places of use authorized under Certificates 87118, 87119, and 87122. Water may not be used at the authorized place of use during the same season in which water was used under the Temporary Transfer.
