ORDER

On December 3, 1979, Edward B. Uffelman submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 3490, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Bidwell Cram, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second of water from Trout Creek, with a date of priority of November 12, 1915, for irrigation of, among other lands, 9.4 acres in NE¼ SW¼, 4.3 acres in SE¼ SW¾, 13.3 acres in SW¾ SE¼ and 3.2 acres in SE½ SE¼ of Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, W.M., being southeast of Highway 97.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 3490, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
