) ORDER REINSTATING PERMIT AND
) EXTENDING TIME

WHEREAS Permit No. 7259 originally in the name of Harry A. Johnson and assigned to Sidney N. Baker on May 31, 1927 has been cancelled on an authorization signed by the said Sidney N. Baker on December 16, 1929, and

WHEREAS it now appears that the property described in said permit is now owned by one Mary Etta Hancock who desires to complete the appropriation of water described in said permit, and who purchased the property with the understanding that the water right under said permit was not cancelled, and


WHEREAS an assignment of said application and permit from Sidney N. Baker to Mary Etta Hancock has been filed for recording in the office of the State Engineer indicating that it was his intention to convey all rights under the permit to the present owner of the land and that it was not his desire that said permit be cancelled, and

WHEREAS no application for permit to appropriate water from Eight Mile Creek has been filed since the order cancelling said permit was entered and no other appropriator will be injured by the reinstatement of the permit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the special order of the State Engineer dated January 11, 1930 by which this permit and other permits were cancelled be revoked insofar as said order applies to said Permit No. 7259 and that the permit be considered as reinstated without loss of priority.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time limit for completion of construction work and complete application of water under said permit be extended until October 1, 1931.
