Authority

OAR 690-385-7200 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfers.

Findings of Fact

1. On August 9, 2011, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10911 from Central Oregon Irrigation District.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10911 in the name of Central Oregon Irrigation District on August 24, 2009. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 78, Pages 741 - 748. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2010.
3. The applicant has completed irrigation on 95.49 acres of the total 101.79 acres approved in the above referenced transfer application.
4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to irrigate the remaining 6.3 acres authorized under the order approving Transfer Application T-10911.
5. Central Oregon Irrigation District has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2012.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-385-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10911.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10911 shall be extended to October 1, 2012.
