Authority

ORS 537.348 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to lease an existing water right for instream purposes. OAR Chapter 690, Division 077 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating instream lease applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. December 5, 2011 George H. and Hendrika Neary filed an application to Lease all of Certificate 87286 to instream use. The Department assigned the application number IL-1194.
- 2. The first right to be leased is as follows:

Certificate: 87286 in the name of GEORGE NEARY; HENDRIKA NEARY,

TRUSTEES (perfected under Permit S-23796)

Use: IRRIGATION of 92.1 acres

Priority Date: JULY 28, 1955

Rate: 1.150 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND AND 414.450 ACRE FEET

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to, 4.5 FOR IRRIGATION acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the

irrigation season of each year.

- 3. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0076(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(1). No comments were received.
- 4. The instream use is as follows:

ROGUE RIVER tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN

Instream Reach: From POD (as described in Finding of Fact #2) to the Mouth of the Rogue River

- 5. Other conditions to prevent injury and enlargement are:
- 6. If approved, this instream lease is not reasonably expected to significantly affect land use as prescribed by ORS 197.180, OAR Chapter 660, Divisions 30 and 31, and OAR Chapter 690, Division 5.
- 7. Based upon review of the application, comments received, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the lease may be modified or revoked under OAR 690-077-0077 if the Department later finds that the lease is causing injury to any existing water right or enlargement of the original right.
- 8. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required. Transfers will be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 and

Division 077. Approval of this lease does not establish a precedent for approval of future leases or transfers.

- 9. The lease will commence on April 2, 2012 and terminate on September 29, 2016.
- 10. The Lessor has requested the option of terminating the lease early with written notice to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077. The lease conforms to the applicable provisions of OAR 690-077-0015.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. That the Lease as described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. The former place of use will no longer receive water as part of these rights, during the term of the lease.
- 3. The lease will terminate on September 29, 2016. The Lessor has the option of terminating the lease each year, with notification to the Department by March 2 of each year, and before any use has occurred on the property.
