Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 13, 2007, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Arlen B. Wood for the Wood Family Trust for Transfer application T-6404.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-6404 on April 26, 2002. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 56, at Page 246. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2003.
- 3. The applicant has installed the new point of diversion and diverted water for irrigation of the land authorized. The required fish screen at the new point of diversion was installed in August 2007.
- 4. The applicant has completed and diverted all water authorized. The installation of the fish screen was not completed within the time allotted in the final order. The prior owner and applicant of the land did not understand that a fish screen was necessary even though fish were not present at the location of the diversion. Arlen B. Wood, Trustee for the Wood Family is complying with all requirements in the final order.
- 5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion be extended to October 1, 2007.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-6404.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes in additional point of diversion and place of use authorized by T-6404, shall be extended to October 1, 2007.
