
ORDER AMENDING
ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3672

The administrative order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 1977, approving water right transfer application No. 3672, in the name of Marguerite Decker, was in error in listing in paragraph three the number of acres owned by the applicant to which the water right described in the certificate recorded at page 6867, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is appurtenant. The order listed 29.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, W.M., when it should have listed "... 20.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, W.M."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that paragraph three of the administrative order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 1977, approving water right transfer application No. 3672, in the name of Marguerite Decker, be, and the same hereby is, amended to read:

"The certificate recorded at page 6867, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Thos. J. Brosnan, describes a right which includes the use of water from Malheur River for irrigation of 20.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, W.M., with a date of priority of August 25, 1902."
