ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7950 submitted by

DICK SNOW  
33263 OREGON TRAIL ROAD  
ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The first right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County as evidenced by Certificate 2586. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1883.

The right allows the use of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraphs 24 and 33 of the decree, and if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 22, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 700 FEET NORTH AND 780 FEET WEST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER, SECTION 22, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  2.0 ACRES  
SECTION 21  
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The second right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 2535. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1883.

The right allows the use of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 34.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraphs 24 and 33 of the decree, and if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 22, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 700 FEET NORTH AND 780 FEET WEST FROM THE S¼ CORNER, SECTION 22, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE¼ SE¼        12.8 ACRES  
SE¼ SE¼        22.0 ACRES  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion to:

SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 31, T 3 N, R 30 E, WM; 430 FEET NORTH AND 450 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER, SECTION 31.

THIS CHANGE TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:


1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
3. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

4. The water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

Certificates 2586 and 2535 are canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
