ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3913

On March 27, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William E. and Diana L. Gamache for approval of a change in place of use from an unnamed stream, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

A water right was established by performance under the provisions of permit No. 37829, in the names of William E. and Diana L. Gamache, for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use for two families, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area for each family, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 17, 1975.

Water for said right is diverted from a point located 500 feet South and 2100 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the McIntyre D.L.C. No. 58, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owner of the lands to which said water is appurtenant, propose to change the place of use of water for domestic supply for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area, from the house site in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 14, without loss of priority, to a certain house site in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 14.

Mr. L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended, a certificate of water right covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding and also confirming the extent of use of water under the provisions of this order shall be issued to the applicants herein.
