Findings of Fact

- The Department issued an order approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-24 on February 4, 2004. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 59, Pages 184 through 194. Two new instream water right certificates were also issued as evidenced by Certificate 80965 and 80966.
- 2. Certificate 80965 and Special Order Volume 59, Pages 184 through 194, contain a scrivener's error. In the order, the scrivener's error is found in Finding of Fact #12, Ultimate Finding of Fact #H, and order item #7a. The order and certificate describe the reach for the instream use as beginning from the North Unit Irrigation District Point of Diversion (POD) on the Deschutes River near River Mile 164. However, the coordinates provided for the POD are incorrectly described as being:

The reach for the instream use is correctly described as being from the North Unit POD on the Deschutes River (SE ¼ NE ¼, Township 17 S, Range 12 East, W.M.; 1700 feet South and 730 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 29) new River Mile 164 to Lake Billy Chinook.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Special Order Volume 59, Page 184 through 194, is corrected as described herein. All other terms and conditions of Special Order Volume 59, Page 184 through 194, remain in effect.
- 2. Certificate 80965 is cancelled.
- 3. Instream Water Right Certificate 82830 is issued to supersede Certificate 80965 and to correctly describe the reach of the instream use.
