ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3827

On October 17, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by H. A. Paetz for approval of a change in place of use from South Myrtle Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 14008, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of H. E. Raymond, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from South Myrtle Creek for irrigation of a certain 0.06 acre in SE^{1}_{4} SE^{1}_{4} of Section 23, and 1.0 acre in NE^{1}_{4} NE^{1}_{4} of Section 26, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 2, 1939.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 8 chains North and 26 chains East from the Internal Corner of the A. Ireland D.L.C. No. 47, being within the NE_4^{1} NE_4^{1} of said Section 26.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.06 acres in NE^{1}_{4} NE^{1}_{4} of said Section 26.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right recorded at page 14008, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources

Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
