Findings of Fact

1. On January 8, 2008, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Richard Robinson for Transfer application T-9281.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9281 on February 14, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 63, at Page 241. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.
3. The applicant has installed the pump, delivery line, filtration system and drip lines and all are operational. 107.9 acres have been irrigated.
4. The applicant submitted a Claim of Beneficial Use on October 15, 2007. The claim was returned by the Department for deficiencies. The applicant needs to resubmit the claim with the correct description of the location in relation to the point of diversion and fish screens and measuring device. The applicant needs to resubmit the map that has been revised to reflect the acreage per water right involved.
5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion be extended to October 1, 2008.

Conclusions of Law


Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9281.

<p>This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.</p>

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes in points of diversion and place of use authorized by T-9281, shall be extended to October 1, 2008.
