# AMENDING ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE, A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION, AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7087 submitted by

ROBERT AND PAMELA ZIELINSKI 12423 RIVER ROAD NE GERVAIS, OREGON 97026.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 47311, was perfected under Permit G-6293 with a date of priority of JANUARY 9, 1975. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 76.4 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.96 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN MORSON DLC 68, SECTION 20, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 1930 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF MORSON DLC 68, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 47312, was perfected under Permit G-6422 with a date of priority of APRIL 10, 1975. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 64.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE¼ SE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN MORSON DLC 68, SECTION 20, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1230 FEET SOUTH AND 3330 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF MORSON DLC 68, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered February 10, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 284, incorrectly listed the authorized quantity of water for Permit G-6422 as 0.96 cubic foot per second. This order correctly lists the authorized quantity as 0.81 cubic foot per second, and should replace the original order.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered February 10, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 281, is rescinded. This corrective order is issued in its place.

Certificates 47311 and 47312 are cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
