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O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION  
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On December 23, 1940, Omer M. Cyrus, Willard H. Cyrus, and Hattie S. Cyrus filed an application for approval of changes in places of use of water within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District.

By an order dated February 25, 1924,<sup>5-40</sup> the State Engineer approved an application of W. F. Arnold and E. T. Slayton, transferring the water rights appurtenant to 25 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1889,<sup>C-298</sup> to 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 15 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., and by an order dated September 30, 1936,<sup>D-10</sup> the State Engineer approved an application of Deschutes County, transferring certain water rights having a date of priority of 1895,<sup>C-850</sup> to, among other lands, 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

The applicants herein, owners of the above-described lands, propose to transfer 10 acres from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 15 acres from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1889, to 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., and to transfer 20 acres from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 5 acres from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1895, to 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 15 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

All the lands involved are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District, and at a regular meeting of the board of directors of the district held on the 6th day of August, 1940, the proposed transfer was approved.

It appears that such changes in places of use can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed changes in places of use of water be and the same hereby are approved and the water rights appurtenant to the following-described lands, to-wit:

be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to the following-described lands, to-wit:

It is FURTHER ORDERED that complete application of water to beneficial use on said lands shall be made on or before October 1, 1942, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
