O R D E R


On November 27, 1978, Arthur R. Zehner and Tom DeArmond submitted affidavits that they are the owner and contract purchaser of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 20761, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Arthur R. Zehner, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream, with a date of priority of August 29, 1946, for irrigation of 4.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Rhodde D.L.C. No. 57, of Section 33, Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 20761, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
