FINAL ORDER APPROVING AN
EXTENSION OF TIME

Authority

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. The Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9776 on December 29, 2004. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 62, Pages 419-422. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.

1. On August 17, 2007, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 73, Pages 114-115, extending the completion date of the authorized change in point of diversion to October 1, 2008.

2. On November 28, 2016, the Department received an application for extension of time for Transfer Application T-9776.

3. The applicant has completed installation of the new points of diversion and applied water to beneficial use.

4. To complete the change, the applicant installed flow meters on October 17, 2008. The applicant was unable to complete the change before the completion date due to a delay in the flow meter delivery.

5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2009.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9776.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes authorized by Transfer Application T-9776 shall be extended to October 1, 2009.
