ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7796 submitted by

KENNETH L. OGREN 10470 SUNNYVIEW ROAD NE SALEM, OREGON 97301.

The permit to be modified is Permit G-12982 with a date of priority of JANUARY 23, 1996. The permit allows the use of A WELL, in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 19.4 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 30.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE% SE%, SECTION 19, T 7 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1430 FEET NORTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SW% SW%, SECTION 19, T 7 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 130 FEET NORTH AND 1600 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.
