Authority

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfers.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 10, 2012, the Department received an application for extension of time for water right transfer T-10306 from Gloria Danley, the transfer applicant.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10306, in the name of Gloria Danley, on October 31, 2008. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 76, at Page 644. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2010.
- 3. The applicant has completed the pump station, distribution system and sprinkler irrigation system, but has been unable to fully complete the change by the deadline because of a contractor's oversight in not installing a flowmeter.
- 4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to add a flowmeter to meet the condition that requires a measurement device, and then make beneficial use of water in compliance with all conditions of the order.
- 5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2013.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10306 and the requested time is reasonable.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10306 shall be extended to October 1, 2013.
