O R D E R

APPROVING APPLICATION

On September 17, 1963, Loren B. and Virginia B. Holzhouser filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River and Crane Prairie Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of the Arnold Irrigation District for the use of the water of Deschutes River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 18.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 10.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 4.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 19.6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M., with dates of priority of February 1, 1905 and April 25, 1905, being tabulated in the name of R. D. Stowell. These lands also have a supplemental right under Permit No. 23256 to the use of the water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir, with a date of priority of February 28, 1913.

The applicants herein, owners of 29.3 acres of the lands above described, to-wit: 13.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 2.4 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 8.1 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 8, propose to transfer the water right therefrom without loss of priority to 16.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 13.3 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 8, owned by Ernest R. and Betty M. Perkins.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides

notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water only.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District and the President and Secretary of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water on September 3, 1963.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and that the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 13.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 2.4 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 8.1 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M., with dates of priority of February 1, 1905, April 25, 1905 and February 28, 1913, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority to 16.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 13.3 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 8, owned by Ernest R. and Betty M. Perkins.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1965, or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Arnold Irrigation District to the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially at the time certificates are issued confirming other transfers within the District.
