O R D E R
APPROVING APPLICATION

On March 15, 1941, S. P. Osburn and W. H. Osburn of Route 2, Box 95, Troutdale, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Osburn Spring Creek.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 2176, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was issued to S. P. Osburn and W. H. Osburn, confirming an appropriation under Permit No. 900 for the use of 0.2 cubic foot per second of the waters of Osburn Spring Creek for domestic purposes and the irrigation of 8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M., with a date of priority of October 13, 1911, through the Osburn pipe line, the point of diversion of said pipe line being located 1,500 feet north and 1,063 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M.


The applicants herein, owners of the above-described lands, propose to change the present point of diversion upstream approximately 150 feet to a point to be located 1,334 feet north and 1,005 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M.

The change in point of diversion being less than one-fourth mile and there being no intervening diversions between the old diversion of the applicants and their proposed new diversion, notice as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., is not required.

On March 20, 1941, Mr. D. J. McLellan, Assistant State Engineer, made an examination of the premises involved, and from his report on said examination it appears that the proposed change can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Osburn Spring Creek, to-wit: From a point located 1,500 feet north and 1,068 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M., to a point upstream approximately 150 feet to be located 1,334 feet north and 1,005 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M., be and the same hereby is approved.
