



3. The August 31, 2021 request for extension of time stated NUID was unable to apply water to full beneficial use as required by the Order due to the extreme drought.
4. NUID has requested a two year extension of time to apply the water to full beneficial use.
5. The records on file with the Department confirm the presence of a severe on-going drought. On June 8, 2021, the Governor declared a drought in Jefferson County.


### Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown good cause for an extension of time for applying the conserved water to full beneficial use for a two year period.

### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for applying the conserved water to full beneficial use authorized by Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-115 shall be extended to **October 1, 2023**. Within one year of applying the conserved water to full beneficial use, a Claim of Beneficial Use shall be prepared and submitted.
