Findings of Fact

- 1. On April 15, 2021, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-13609 authorizing temporary changes in places of use under Certificates 87111, 92994, 93872, 95154, and 95955. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 120, Pages 195-211.
- 2. Under the order approving T-13609, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2025 irrigation season.
- 3. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer T-13609 was during the 2021 irrigation season.
- 4. On April 15, 2021, Certificate 95154 was superseded by Certificate 95660, and Certificate 95154 was superseded by Certificate 95662 upon the finalization of CW-119.
- 5. On March 8, 2022, Nathan Rue, on behalf of Farmland Reserve, owner of the lands to which water right Certificates 95660 and 95662 are appurtenant, submitted a written request to terminate a portion of temporary Transfer T-13609, being 21.87 acres under Certificate 95660 and 30.78 acres under Certificate 95662.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. The remaining portion of temporary transfer T-13609, being 567.82 acres under Certificate 87111, 490.55 acres under Certificate 93872, and 148.59 acres under Certificate 92994 shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2025 irrigation season, or earlier, if requested in writing by the applicant.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Transfer T-13609 is hereby partially terminated as described in Finding of Fact #5, above.
- 2. The place of use for the 21.87 acres under Certificate 95660 (previously 95154) and 30.78 acres under Certificate 95662 (previously 95155) shall revert to the original authorized place of use.
- 3. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 120, Pages 195-211 approving the temporary transfer of 567.82 acres under Certificate 87111, 490.55 acres under Certificate 93872, and the 148.59 acres under Certificate 92994 remain in effect.
