ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 4549

On June 26, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Richard Corbet for approval of a change in place of use of water from Well Number 14, pursuant to the provisions of 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 35222, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Harry Pon, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second from Well Number 14 for supplemental irrigation of 3.2 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32 and 31.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, Township 22 South, Range 31 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 3, 1961.

The authorized point of appropriation is located 530 feet North and 1200 feet East from the Southwest Corner, Section 33, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 22 South, Range 31 East, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to use said water for supplemental irrigation of 8.2 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 10.0 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 16.0 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 33, Township 22 South, Range 31 East, W.M.

Mr. William H. Beal, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 35222, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
