O R D E R

On January 2, 1980, Herbert H. Hendricks submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered March 17, 1924, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Pine Creek, tabulated at Page 160, Volume 7, Order Record of the Water Resources Director in the name of John W. Langdon, and is described by the certificate recorded at Page 5524, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John W. Langdon, and is for the use of not to exceed 1 cubic foot per second per acre from Dry Creek, with a date of priority of 1882, for irrigation of a certain 11.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32,, T6N, R35E, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, described by the certificate recorded at Page 5524, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled.
