## ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND REDUCING FOUR PERMITS

Pursuant to ORS 537.252 and ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-8137 submitted by

MEDFORD IRRIGATION DISTRICT 1340 MYERS LANE MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

ROGUE RIVER VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT 3131 MERRIMAN ROAD MEDFORD, OREGON 97501-1277.

The permits to be modified are E-19, 407, 1705, 1706, 2362, and 30364.

The authorized place of use, under all the permits, is located as follows:

NE% SW% 7.1 ACRES

SECTION 8

TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

NE¼ NW¼ 7.6 ACRES SECTION 8

NE¼ SE¼ 6.6 ACRES SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicants propose to change the place of use, for Permits E-19 and 407, to:

SE¼ SE¼ 2.0 ACRES SECTION 10

SW¼ SW¼ 18.0 ACRES SE¼ SW¼ 1.0 ACRE SECTION 11

NW% NW% 0.3 ACRE SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

Proof, satisfactory to the Water Resources Director, has been received that the authorized places of use have been irrigated within the terms and conditions of the permits.

Water from the sources described in Permits 1705, 1706, 2362, and 30364 may not be delivered to the proposed place of use. The Districts have requested to remove these lands from these permits.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING PERMITS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE PERMIT HOLDERS:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed prior to October 1, 2000.
- 2. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of these permits.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the permits shall remain the same.

Permits E-19, and 407 are amended as described herein. Permits 1705, 1706, 2362 and 30364 are reduced as described herein. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, the lands described herein may be included in the certificates confirming Permits E-19 and 407.
