ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Jeld-Wen Inc. filed an application to add an additional point of appropriation under both Certificate 42736 (199.4 acres) and Permit G-10695 (306.2 acres). The Department assigned the application number T-6772.
- 2. On July 22, 2004, Certificate 80805 was issued for irrigation of 206.6 acres, thus only approximately two-thirds of the acreage requested in the transfer application under Permit G-10695 is subject to transfer.
- 3. The first right to be modified is as follows:

Certificate: 42736 in the name of L.L. STEWART (perfected under Permit G-1790)

Use: IRRIGATION of 199.4 ACRES Priority Date: MARCH 8, 1961

Rate: 2.49 CFS

Limit/Duty: ONE-EIGHTIETH cfs per acre, not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre per year

Source: Well in BUCK CREEK Basin (tributary to LOST RIVER Basin)

7. T-6772 requests that water from the new point of appropriation under Certificates 42736 and 80805 be linked in a common delivery system with the existing points of appropriation under those rights.

- 8. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation proposed in application T-6772 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The changes proposed in T-6772 are approved; subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 42736 and 80805 and any related decree.
- 2. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 3. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2006.
- 4. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2007.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 6. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 7. Certificates 42736 and 80805 are cancelled; upon approval of a Claim of Beneficial Use, new certificates shall be issued to confirm the transferred rights.
