Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

1. Sunriver Water, LLC submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan (plan) to the Water Resources Department (Department) on July 8, 2021. The required statutory fee for review of the plan was received by the Department on July 14, 2021. The plan was required by July 30, 2020, in a condition set forth under Permit G-17460 (now Permit G-17882) issued July 30, 2015.
2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on July 27, 2021, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
3. The Department provided written comments on the plan to the City on September 17, 2021. In response, the City of Sunriver submitted a revised plan on December 20, 2021.
4. The Department provided written comments on the revised plan to the City on January 10, 2022. In response, the City of Sunriver submitted a second revised plan on July 7, 2022.
5. The Department reviewed the second revised plan and finds that the second revised plan is consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Conclusion of Law

The Water Management and Conservation Plan submitted by Sunriver Water, LLC, is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Duration of Plan Approval:

1. The Sunriver Water, LLC, Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until **July 7, 2033**, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

Development Limitation:

2. The limitation of the diversion of water under Permit G-17882 established in the Final Order approving an Extension of Time for Permit G-17460 (*issued on April 1, 2022*) remains unchanged. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the City of Sunriver remains authorized to divert only up to **5.25 Acre Feet (AF) (out of the total maximum volume permitted of 1790.0 AF) of water under Permit G-17882.**

Plan Update Schedule:

3. The Sunriver Water, LLC, shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective December 23, 2018) within ten (10) years and no later than **January 7, 2033.**


Progress Report Schedule:

4. The Sunriver Water, LLC, shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by **July 7, 2028.**

Other Requirements for Plan Submittal:

5. The deadline established herein for the submittal of an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan (consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 086) shall not relieve Sunriver Water, LLC, from any existing or future requirement(s) for submittal of a Water Management and Conservation Plan at an earlier date as established through other final orders of the Department.
