ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7175 submitted by

REEVE L. HENNION 3232 LITTLE APPLEGATE ROAD JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 34529, was perfected under Permit 4975 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 28, 1921. The right allows the use of the LITTLE APPLEGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.6 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized points of diversion: 1. CENTER OF NW% NE%, SECTION 29, T 39 S, R 2 W, W.M. AND 2. NW% NW%, SECTION 26, T 39 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1320 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER, SECTION 26, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE% SE% 5.5 ACRES
SE% SE% 5.1 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

NW% SE%, SECTION 13, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 970 FEET SOUTH AND 560 FEET EAST FROM CENTER % CORNER, SECTION 13.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 34529 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
