On January 12, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Constance Sowell for approval of a change in place of use of water from Glade Fork, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16334, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Minnie F. Storch, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second from Glade Fork for irrigation of a certain 7.0 acres in NW¹₄ NW¹₄ of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 4, 1899.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Mill Ditch, from a point located 110 feet North and 940 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 15, being within the SE^{1}_{4} SE^{1}_{4} of Section 15, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain other 5.2 acres in NW_4 NW_4 and 1.8 acres in SW_4 NW_4 of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 16334, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and

beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
