ORDER

On March 4, 1983, Donald W. Hull, Attorney for Diamond Fruit Growers, Incorporated, submitted an affidavit that Diamond Fruit Growers, Incorporated, is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that Diamond Fruit Growers, Incorporated, has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 14958, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of O.M. Dewit, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.185 cubic foot per second of water from two springs in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26 and one spring in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1882, for irrigation of 0.01 acre in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 6.01 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 8.25 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 0.56 acre in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM.


Another portion of the water right described by Certificate 14958 is involved in Transfer 5204, filed on February 17, 1983, by Diamond Fruit Growers, Incorporated, for a change in use heretofore made of water.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 14958, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding, and not involved in Transfer 5204.
