ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7708 submitted by

WAMPLER - WERTH FARMS
2490 SOUTH WILLIAMS ROAD
POWELL BUTTE, OREGON 97753.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 68756, was perfected under Permit G-8720 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 11, 1978. The right allows the use of WELLS #1, #2, #3, and #4 in the CROOKED RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 533.8 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 96.4 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 8.08 cubic feet per second, if available at the original wells; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 15 S., R. 14 E., W.M.; Well #1 - 980 feet North and 1950 feet West from the SE corner of Section 11; Well #2 - 2550 feet North and 2550 feet East from the SE corner of Section 11; Well #3 - 2060 feet South and 2600 feet West from the NE corner of Section 11, and Well #4 - 1090 feet North and 1480 feet West from the SE corner of Section 11, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be reduced.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of appropriation at:


NE¼ SW¼, Section 11, T. 15 S., R. 14 E., W.M.; 2370 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET NORTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 11.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 68756 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
