Authority

OAR 690-380-8002(3) and 690-380-8004(7) provide that the uses authorized under a temporary transfer revert to the terms and conditions of the originating water right on the written request of the applicant.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 11, 2018, Farmland Reserve, Inc., filed an application to temporarily change the place of use under Certificates 92990 and 92992 for a period of five years. The Department assigned the application number T-12946.
- 2. On August 23, 2018, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving Temporary Transfer Application T-12946. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 109, Pages 157-162.
- 3. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2022 irrigation season.
- 4. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer was during the 2019 irrigation season.
- 5. On February 21, 2020, FARMLAND RESERVE, INC., the applicant, submitted a written request via e-mail, requesting Temporary Transfer T-12946 be voluntarily terminated.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer T-12946 is terminated. The use shall revert to the place of use authorized under Certificates 92990 and 92992. Water may not be used at the authorized place of use during the same season in which water was used under the Temporary Transfer.
