Findings of Fact

1. On February 10, 2021, the Department issued an order approving Transfer T-13414. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 118, Pages 517-521.
2. The order contained a scrivener’s error in the new point of diversion section location.
3. The correct section location of the point of diversion in bold as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
32 S	5 W	WM	14	NE NW	806 FEET SOUTH AND 622 FEET EAST FROM THE C1/4 OF SECTION 14

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order approving T-13414, as recorded in Special Order Volume 118, Pages 517-521 is corrected to correct the section location of the new point of diversion.
2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 118, Pages 517-521 remain in effect.
