AMENDING ORDER

An Order of the Water Resources Director was entered March 4, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 324, approving Transfer 7509. It was pointed out that the order contains an error, and should be corrected.

The order, on page 326, reads:

The third right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by Certificate 55564. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1880.

The right allows the use of OCHOCO CREEK, a tributary of THE CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATING 40.0 ACRES AND STOCK. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock use, and 0.75 cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year, if available at the original point of diversion: SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 36, T 14 S, R 17 E, WM; OCHOCO DITCH - 350 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 36, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water is in error. The correct quantity of water is 0.50 cubic foot per second.

The order should read:

The third right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by Certificate 55564. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1880.

The right allows the use of OCHOCO CREEK, a tributary of THE CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATING 40.0 ACRES AND STOCK. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock use, and 0.50 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year, if available at the original point of diversion: SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 36, T 14 S, R 17 E, WM; OCHOCO DITCH - 350 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 36, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The Order of the Water Resources Director was entered March 4, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 324, approving Transfer 7509, is amended as described above.
