**Findings of Fact**

1. On June 30, 2021, the Department issued an order to revert a point of diversion under Transfer Application T-5161, involving Certificates 22997 and 22998. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 120, Page 1034.
2. On July 9, 2021, the Department identified a scrivener's error, in identifying an incorrect certificate number, being Certificate 22997:

On November 18, 1982, DONALD BIEBERSTEDT filed an application requesting to change the points of diversion under Certificates **22997** and 22998. The Department assigned the application number T-5161.

3. Finding of Fact number 1 is modified to read as follows:

On November 18, 1982, DONALD BIEBERSTEDT filed an application requesting to change the points of diversion under Certificates 22998 and **45934**. The Department assigned the application number T-5161.


**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The correcting order, as issued on June 30, 2021, is modified to correctly describe the certificates involved in transfer application T-5161.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 120, Page 1034 remain in effect.
