ORDER AMENDING ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER 4268

On August 2, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William A. Vaughn for approval of a change in place of use of water from Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered April 29, 1980, at page 167, Volume 33, Special Order Record, approving Transfer 4268, was in error in allowing 0.115 cubic foot per second from Cow Creek.

The amount of water that should be allowed is 3.8 Miners Inches (0.096 cfs).

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that line 3, paragraph 2, page 167 of said Volume 33 be amended to allow 3.8 Miners Inches of water from Cow Creek.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 49657, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued allowing the use of 8.7 Miners Inches of water from Cow Creek for irrigation of 5.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 5.4 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM; and a confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
