## ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 7754 submitted by

The authorized points of appropriation are:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The change is temporary. The change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.

- 2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the 1997 irrigation season.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 1997 irrigation season.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 5. The use of water under this water right shall be supplemental to any other existing water rights for irrigation on the same lands.
- 6. Prior to use of water, the water user shall obtain permission from the irrigation district for use of its facilities.
- 7. The water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water placed into and taken out of the Canal. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
