ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7150 submitted by

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IMPROVEMENT DITCH COMPANY 205 MAIN STREET LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 3326, was perfected under Permit 1248 with a date of priority of MARCH 9, 1912. The right allows the use of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION. The amount of water to which his right is entitled is limited to an amount beneficially used and shall not exceed 13.38 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE% NE%, Section 5, T 3 S, R 38 E, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured undater any other right for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 28 E, WM; 640 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST OF THE S¼ CORNER, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, W. M.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The improvement company shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The improvement company shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Certificate 3326 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
