ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7753 submitted by

RICK L. HALE P.O. BOX 110 HERMISTON, OREGON 97838.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 53255, was perfected under Permit G-7183 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 25, 1977. The right allows the use of WELL 2, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 237.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.97 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW% SE%, SECTION 24, T 4 N, R 28 E, WM; 1230 FEET NORTH AND 1910 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 24, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to add a point of appropriation to:

SE% SW%, SECTION 9, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; SIEBEL WELL - 380 FEET NORTH AND 3120 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 9.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

5. Prior to use of water, the proposed well must be both recased and resealed to a minimum depth of 310 feet below land surface in order to prevent commingling of water between aquifers.

Certificate 53255 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
