ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4577

On July 31, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Carl and Betty Jane Sheedy for approval of a change in place of use of water from Little Pine Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of Circuit Court for Grant County, entered November 16, 1956, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of John Day River, tabulated at page 592, Volume 10, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, a water right was allowed in the name of C. L. Roddick and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 25765, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of C. L. Roddick, Joe F. Klink and A. P. Rothkopf, and is for the use of water from Little Pine Creek, with a date of priority of 1888, for irrigation of a certain 9.6 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, W.M.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Barnard Ditch, from a point located 580 feet South and 70 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.1 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 4.5 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, 1.0 acre in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, W.M. and 3.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 (Lot 4), Section 5, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, W.M.

Mr. Jerry Rodgers, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 25765, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
