# BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF OREGON

In the Matter of Transfer Application ) FINAL ORDER APPROVING A T-11393, Umatilla County ) DISTRICT TEMPORARY TRANSFER

#### Authority

ORS 540.570 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to temporarily transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

### **Applicant**

WESTLAND IRRIGATION DISTRICT PO BOX 944 HERMISTON, OR 97838

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On April 6, 2012, Stacey Wells, on behalf of Westland Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to temporarily change the place of use under Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128 and 79439, within the boundaries of the irrigation district. The Department assigned the application number T-11393.
- 2. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published April 24, 2012 pursuant to ORS 540.570 and OAR 690-385-3400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The portion of the primary irrigation right and the layered supplemental rights to be transferred are as follows:

Certificate: 76051, issued in the name of Teel Irrigation District (perfected under Permit

S-25924)

Use: Irrigation of 119.2 acres **Priority Date:** June 27, 1958

Rate & Duty: ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (cfs) (or its equivalent) and

4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Source: Umatilla River, a tributary of the Columbia River

Rate & Duty: ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The diversion shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

- 6. The district temporary transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-3000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-3200, and includes a map meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-3300.
- 7. The District shall measure the "amount in" and "amount out" in regards to the use of the supplemental water rights and shall maintain both a flow meter where the groundwater is pumped into the Westland Canal, and a meter to measure the amount of water that is pumped out of the Westland canal to the new places of use.
- 8. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 9. The proposed changes in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 10. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

#### Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11393 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.570.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary changes proposed in Transfer Application T-11393 are approved.
- 2. The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2012 irrigation season.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2012 irrigation season.
- 4. The right to the use of the water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128 and 79439 and any related decree.
- 5. The use of water on the lands from which the water right is transferred and at the new temporary place of use during the same irrigation season or calendar year is prohibited and may subject the district and landowner to civil penalties.
- 6. The use of water for supplemental irrigation at the proposed places of use under Certificate 61534, 75126 and 75128, as described in Findings of Fact #4, is restricted to the total rate and duty described by Certificate 61534, 75126 and 75128, and may be used only to make up a deficiency of supply.
- 7. The supplemental irrigation use of Certificate 61534 on the lands identified in Finding of Fact #5 is prohibited.
- 8. The applicant shall install a measurement device at the site where groundwater is pumped into the Westland Canal. The District shall also operate and maintain a measurement device at the point where the District pumps from the Westland Canal to the proposed places of use. The District shall measure and record the amount of water monthly and provide the information to the Watermaster upon request.
- 9. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement devices and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 10. The use of water under this temporary transfer may be conditioned or revoked at any time to the extent necessary to avoid injury if the Department finds the transfer causes injury to any existing water right.
- 11. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128 and 79439 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Divisions 380 and 385. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 12. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

13. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128 and 79439 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128 and 79439.
