ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER 5363

On September 2, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Michael W. Mattis for approval of a change in place of use of water from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 47621, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Michael W. Mattis, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second from ground water for irrigation of 5.1 acres in Lot 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) and 10.7 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM, with a date of priority of September 10, 1975.

The authorized point of appropriation is located 2600 feet South and 2980 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM (Mattis Irrigation Well 2).

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to 6.7 acres in Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), 8.7 acres in Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) and 0.4 acre in Lot 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 31, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM. The change in place of use is reported to be completed.

Dennis R. Glender, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use, is approved without loss of priority.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

That the pump system shall include an in line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Michael W. Mattis and recorded at page 47621, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
