ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2626

On April 10, 1972, Olson-Lawyer Lumber, Inc., filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in place of use of water from Mill Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at page 27741, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ross Lumber Co., as modified by the provisions of the order of the State Engineer entered on July 2, 1962, in approval of water right transfer application No. 0-36, confirms an existing right of record which includes the use of not to exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second from Mill Creek for domestic purposes for ten families, being three single family units in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, five single family units in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ and two single family units partially within SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ and partially within NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 10, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 19, 1941.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 1921 feet North and 2729 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 28, being within the NW_4^{1} SE $_{4}^{1}$ of Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the water right above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use from two certain single family units in NE_4^1 SW $_4^1$ of Section 10, and in lieu thereof serve two additional single family units in SE_4^1 NW $_4^1$ of Section 10, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order and the order approving transfer No. 2624 a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
