ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE
AND CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, a portion of TRANSFER 7152 and TRANSFER 7361 submitted by

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IMPROVEMENT DITCH COMPANY
205 MAIN STREET
LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 3323, was perfected under Permit 902 with a date of priority of JULY 25, 1911. The right allows the use of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 74.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.93 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 34.1 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 40.0 ACRES
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change use point of diversion to:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM; 640 FEET
NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST FROM THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 32.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	17.5 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	20.0 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	19.5 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	17.1 ACRES

SECTION 13

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.


The remainder of Transfer Application 7152, which requests a change in point of diversion, will be considered separately.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
3. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The improvement company shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.
6. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 3323 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
