WHEREAS, on September 21, 1936, the Squaw Creek Irrigation District filed an application for the approval of an exchange of water rights within the boundaries of said district, and

WHEREAS, there is a water right appurtenant to the $NE_4^1NW_4^1$, Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M., for the irrigation of 40 acres, with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, by virtue of an order of the State Engineer dated February 23, 1934, approving transfer of water right, and

WHEREAS, by an order of the State Engineer dated September 11, 1930, approving an application for transfer of water rights, a water right is appurtenant to the $SE_4^1SW_4^1$, Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., for the irrigation of 37 acres with a date of priority of 1904 and 2.5 acres with a date of priority of November, 1904, and

WHEREAS, the applicant herein proposes to transfer 30 acres of the water right appurtenant to said NE₄¹NW₄¹, Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, to 30 acres in the SE₄¹SW₄, Section 33, Fownship 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., and simultaneously to transfer 30 acres of water rights appurtenant to said SE₄¹SW₂, Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., to 30 acres in the NE₄¹NW₄, Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M., and

WHEREAS, the State Engineer has given due consideration to the matter and it appears that such an exchange of water rights may

be made without injury to existing rights,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that said application for an exchange of water rights be and the same is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said water to be transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1938, or within any extension of said time as the State Engineer may grant for good cause shown.
