Findings of Fact

1. On June 22, 2015, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-11947. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 96, Pages 344 - 347.
2. A scrivener's error was found in the order on page 345.
3. The scrivener's error was found in the proposed point of diversion table in Finding No. 6 on Page 345. The table inaccurately describes the quarter-quarter (Q-Q) designation of the proposed POD as being in the NE SW quarter-quarter of Section 2, Twp. 12 S. Rng. 6 W.:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	DLC	Measured Distances
12 S	6 W	WM	2	NE SW	49	70 FEET NORTH AND 55 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER, KENNEDY DLC 77

4. The correct quarter-quarter designation is in the NE NW of Section 2, as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	DLC	Measured Distances
12 S	6 W	WM	2	NE NW	49	70 FEET NORTH AND 55 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER, KENNEDY DLC 77


Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order approving Transfer Application T-11947, recorded at Special Order Volume 96, Pages 344 - 347 is amended to correct a scrivener error described in this order.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
