Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 27, 2004, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Deborah Lee Seney, formerly known as Deborah Schroeder.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8471 on April 18, 2003. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 57, at Page 465. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2004, and the date for submission of a claim of beneficial use as October 1, 2005.
- 3. The applicant has irrigated the 2.15 acres of land.
- 4. The applicant requested an extension because they are unable to complete development of the requested point of diversion and place of use by the completion date. The applicant needs to coordinate the type and plan of the headgate with the Department. The applicant also needs to work with the Department of Fish and Wildlife on installation of the fishcreens.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8471.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the change in point of diversion and place of use, authorized by T-8471 shall be extended to October 1, 2005.
