ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4302

On October 10, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Archie Reikkola, President, Lewis and Clark Seed Company, for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of U.S. Reclamation Service, describes a right which includes the use of water from Umatilla River for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 28, 1909.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the West Extension Ditch, from a point located 1000 feet North and 500 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 28, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 30.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, W.M.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources

Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order the certificate heretofore issued to U.S. Reclamation Service and recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
